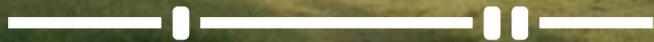

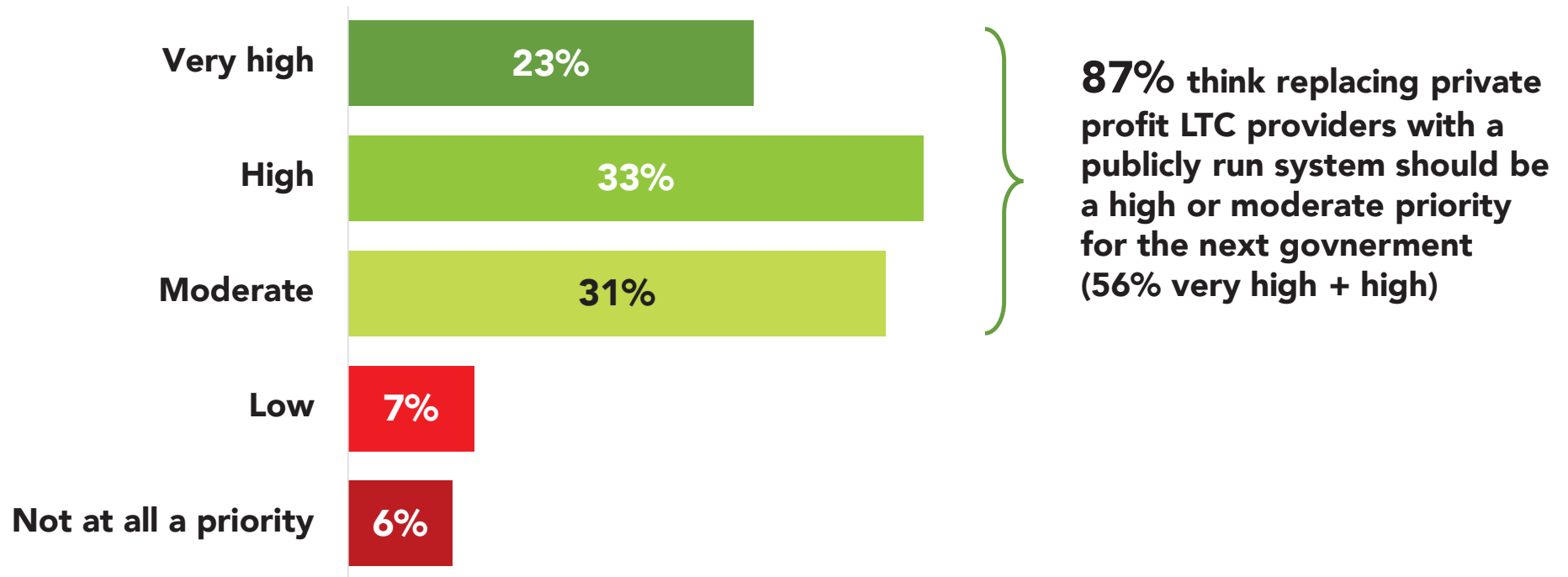


# KEY FINDINGS

- 1. 8 in 10 (81%) agree that the federal government should increase its funding for long term care facilities.**
- 2. 7 in 10 (71%) feel that the currently privatized LTC providers should be replaced by a publicly run system.**
- 3. Support for these LTC initiatives is strongest among older Canadians, Atlantic Canadians, and LPC & NDP voters.**

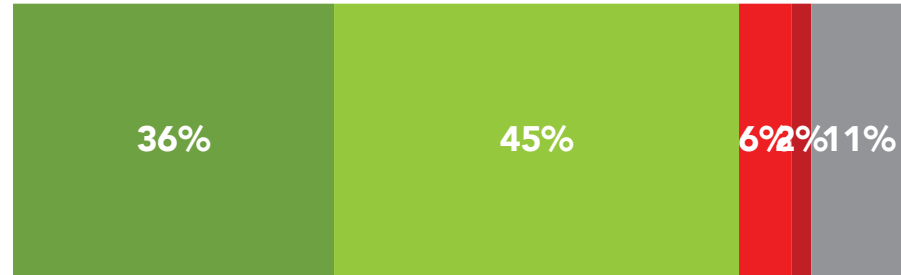

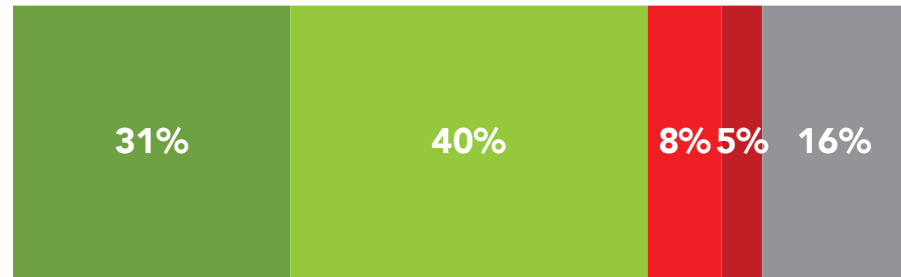

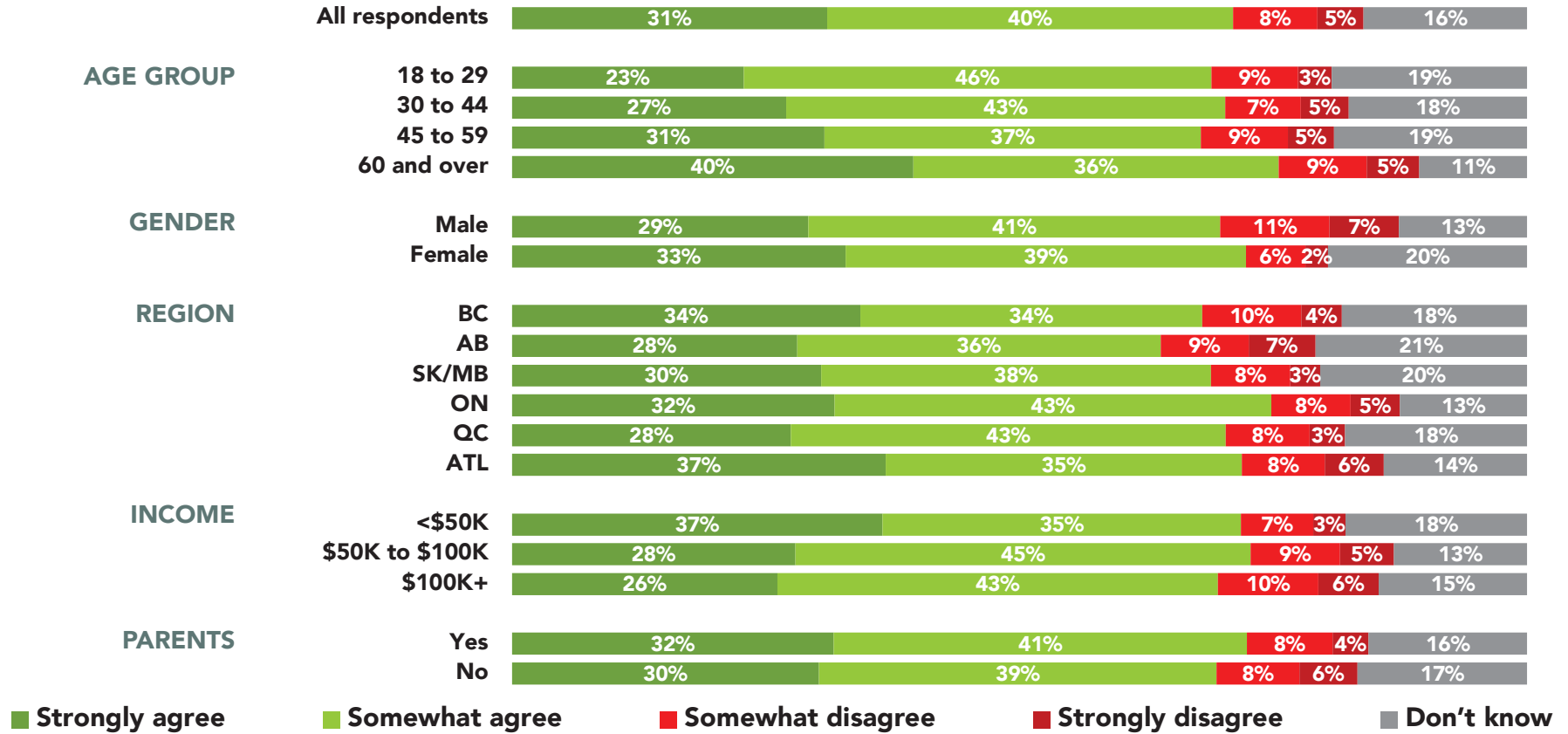

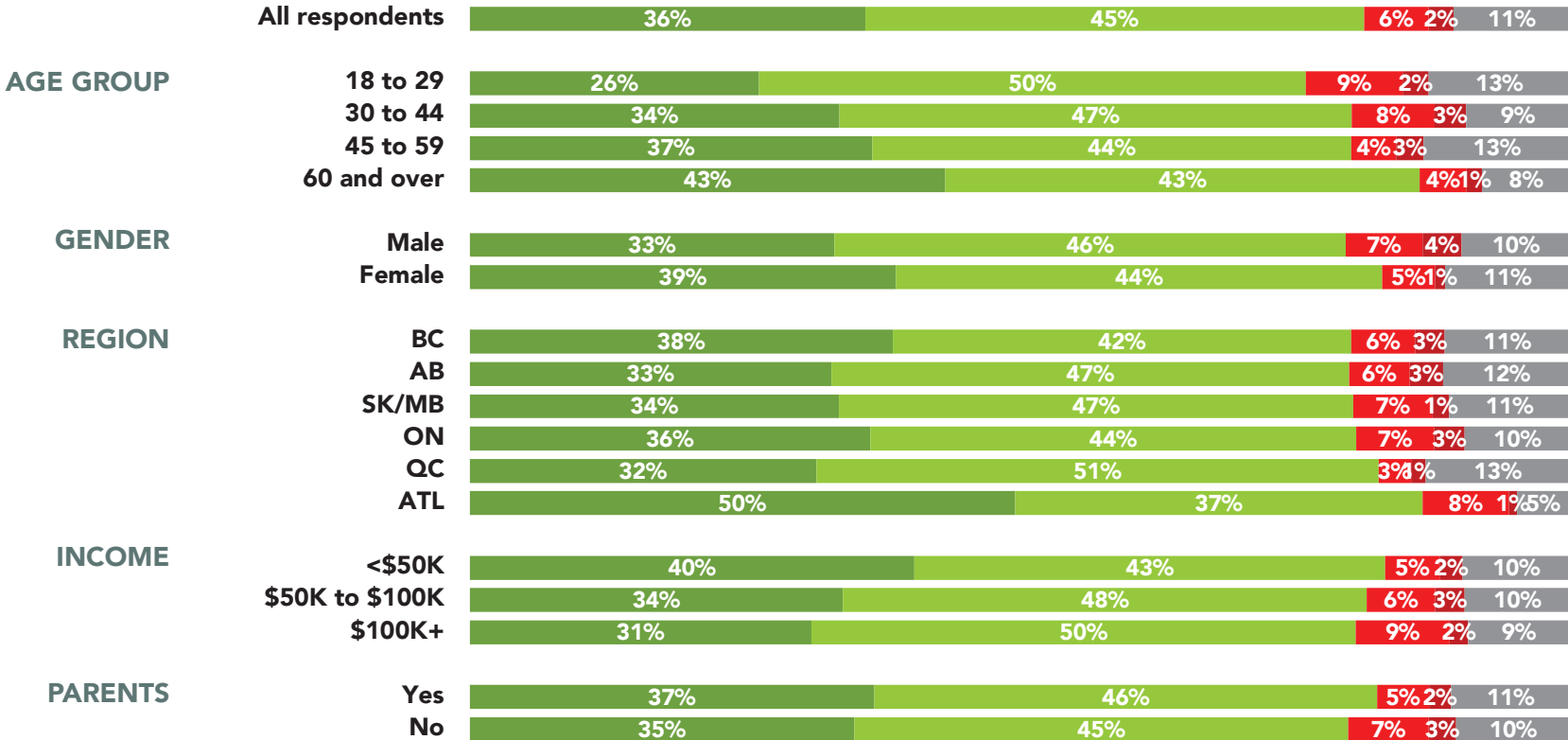
