
## OFFENDER COVID-19 DECISION-MAKING TOOL FOR NURSES

In the past 14 days has the offender:

- travelled outside of Saskatchewan; OR
- been in close contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case; <u>OR</u>
- was in an indoor environment for a prolonged period with <u>></u> 25 people; <u>OR</u>
- was in the same indoor environment with a positive COVID-19 case for a prolonged period but did not meet the definition of close contact (e.g. family, classroom, waiting room, etc.).



Ensure offender is wearing procedural mask. Notify ADDO for immediate placement of offender in an isolation cell.

YES



Does the offender have symptoms of influenza-like illness (ILI)?

Onset of **NEW** cough (or changes in existing cough), **OR** severe difficulty breathing

PLUS, one or more of the following:

Fever ≥ 38°C Sore throat Joint pain Muscle aches





Offender to remain in isolation for 14 days. If asymptomatic no other precautions except Universal needed. Notify facility physician. All other offenders that have been in contact with offender should also be isolated for 14 days and monitored for symptoms. Monitor daily unless other direction obtained from physician. If symptoms develop initiate Droplet/Contact Precautions (procedural mask,


and eye protection: googles or face shield, gown and gloves) and contact Public Health for further direction. Notify facility physician. Offender can be removed from isolation if remains asymptomatic for 14

Does the offender have symptoms of influenza-like illness (ILI)?

Onset of **NEW** cough (or changes in existing cough), **OR** severe difficulty breathing

PLUS, one or more of the following:

Fever ≥ 38 °C Sore throat Joint pain Muscle aches



## Initiate **Droplet/Contact**

Precautions (procedural mask and eye protection, goggles or face shield, gown and gloves)
Contact Public Health for further direction and notify facility physician. The unit the offender is from should be quarantined until further notice.

Only when performing Aerosol Generating Medical Procedure (AGMP) are **Droplet/Contact PLUS\* Precautions required** (\*N95 and eye protection, goggles or face shield, gown and gloves). Ensure door and food slot closed with AGMP procedures (consult ADDO if security concerns).



Initiate Droplet & Contact
Precautions (procedural mask, and eye protection: googles or face shield, gown and gloves).
Immediately contact Public Health for further direction and notify facility physician. The unit the offender is from should be quarantined until further notice.
