## Electoral Reform - Track Record & Campaign Promises



Currently has no official position.

In government, reneged on a promise of electoral reform when a parliamentary committee proposed proportional representation.



Requires a referendum before any electoral reform can be implemented and doesn't officially favour any particular option.

Open to considering electoral reform.



Introduce proportional representation (Mixed-Member Proportional) for the next election, and once Canadians have the opportunity to experience the new voting system, hold a referendum to confirm the choice.

Will replace SMP with a Mixed-Member Proportional (MMP) system of proportional representation.

Will establish an independent citizens' assembly to recommend the best way to put MMP in place for the next election.

Will lower the voter age to 16.

Will hold social media platforms responsible for flagging and removing fraudulent accounts, and will respond promptly to harassment, threats, and hate speech.



Will replace the Single Member Plurality (SMP) system with a system of proportional representation.

Will reduce financial barriers to running for political office.

Will lower the voting age to 16 to encourage more youth participation.
